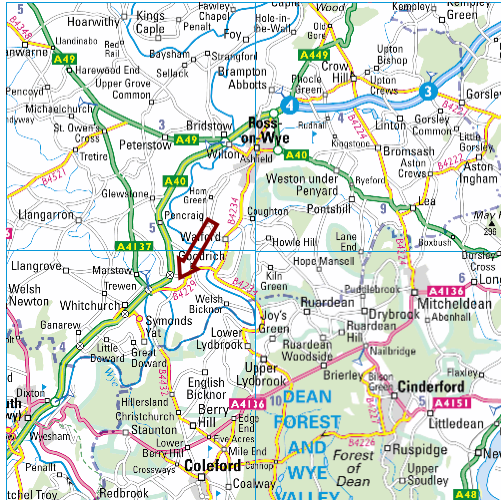

### Driving Directions

#### **From Ross-on-Wye (Via the A40 Southbound)**

Take the A40 towards Monmouth and proceed for around 4 miles. There are 2 exits for Goodrich around 500 yards apart, take the second exit.

#### **From Monmouth (Via the A40 Northbound)**

Take the A40 towards Ross-on-Wye and take the exit signposted Goodrich. Follow the slip road round a right hand bend and over the bridge. At the junction turn left towards Goodrich.

#### **Following on from both of the above...**

Proceed along this road for approximately 1.5 miles. You will see Granton House on the corner. Follow the road round (sharp bend) and The Old Vicarage is the last property on the left hand side on this road – if you go down a steep hill to a junction you've gone too far!  
You enter the property along a drive through a graveled gateway, the Old Vicarage is in front of you with a courtyard area on your left, marked L.E.A. Proceed into the courtyard where there is ample parking. You will see the L.E.A. office door on the ground floor to the right. Please ring the bell for assistance.
